Instrument of Government

1. The name of the school is **Crowle Church of England First School**
2. The school is a **Voluntary Controlled Church school**
3. The name of the Governing Body is **The Governing Body of Crowle Church of England First School**
4. The Governing Body shall consist of:
 - a) **2** Parent Governors
 - b) **1** Local Authority Governors
 - c) **1** Staff Governors
 - d) **1** Headteacher
 - e) **2** Foundation Governors
 - f) **4** Co-Opted Governors
5. Total number of Governors **11**
6. The term of office for Governors is **4 years**
7. **The Board of Education of the Diocese of Worcester** shall appoint 1 Foundation governor.
8. (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:
The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Crowle with Bredicot

(b)**The Archdeacon of Dudley** shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.
9. **The Archdeacon of Dudley** shall be entitled to remove any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
10. **Ethos Statement**

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and Diocesan level.
